Late Lala Jagan Nath R/o. No. 2759, Subzi Mandi, Delhi-7, (2) Mr. Lalit Gupta S/o. Late Lala Jagan Nath R/o. No. 74, Tadar Mal Road, Bengali Market, New Delhi-1, (3) Mr. Harsh Gupta S/o. Mr. Lalit Gupta R/o. No. 74, Tadar Mal Road, Bengali Market, New Delhi-1, (4) Mr. Paval Gupta S/o. Mr. Raj Kumar Gupta R/o. No. 2759, Subzi Mandi, Delhi-7, (5) Mrs. Swarna Gupta W/o. Dr. A.K. 
NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH THAT for carrying out such desire into the effect, the Settlor BOTH hereby grant, transfer and assign UNTO the Trustees the said sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) AND all the estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand of the Settlor together with all income issues thereof and all the investments for the time being representing the same, and all additions thereof and accretions thereto and all accumulations thereof and conversions thereof and all moveable and immoveable properties acquired thereby (hereinafter collectively referred to as the Trust Estate) UNTO and TO the Trustees out of the said sum to HAVE and HOLD the said sum UNTO and to the use of the Trustees upon and subject to the Trust powers and provisions hereinafter declared and expressed by and between the parties hereto as follows:-

1. The Public Charitable Trust hereby established shall be designated as ' Rai Bahadur Ram Roop Trust' and its office shall be located at No. 2759, Gali Ram Roop Street, Subzi Mandi, Delhi-7, or any other place as the Trustees may decide later on.


2. The date of commencement shall be the execution of this Deed.

3. OBJECTS:- The objects for which the trust has been established are and shall be as follows:-

3.1 To take up and establish (1) colleges affiliated to the University of Delhi or any other University; (2) a Homeopathic and other medical colleges and hospitals, and (3) educational

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Institutions to impart education from the Montessori to the Pre-University standard in the first instance and if the resources of the Trust permitted, to be later raised to full fledged colleges.

3.2 To manage and run the training institutions in typing, short hand, computer, Fine Arts, Crafts, Painting, Modelling, Dancing, yoga, physical education and other professional training subjects.

3.3 To work for the educational upliftment of the rural and general public, irrespective of caste, creed, sex and religion.

3.4 To start, establish, run, take over, manage and maintain schools and educational institutions with an object to provide sound kindergarden, nursery, primary, secondary, senior secondary and higher education to children by seeking recognition and affiliation from the educational departments, Boards and any other concerned government authorities etc.

3.5 To manage and run the schools being already run, i.e. Sri Bahadur Path Shiksha Vidya Mandir Senior Secondary School, Lilawati Vidya Mandir Senior Secondary School, Lilawati Vidya Mandir Montessori School and Heritage Play Centre, all situated in Shakti Nagar, Delhi.

3.6 To arrange/organise discussions, seminars, conferences and other lawful gatherings for the promotion of aim and objects of the Trust.

3.7 To establish and manage various kinds of educational, vocational, professional, Industrial, Agricultural, Research and training institutions, to introduce and develop the professional courses and also to arrange/provide all kinds of educational facilities to the students, scholars, trainees and to other needy candidates.

3.8 To impart free education to the poor, helpless and needy children/students, and to sponsor children/students.

3.9 To offer and provide awards, institute fellowships/scholarships, stipends to students and deserving children.

3.10 To conduct coaching classes for preparations of the various competitive examinations.

- 3.11 To provide free/subsidised food, clothing, medical aid, books, stationery, transportation, hostel, reading rooms, play grounds, sports complex, physical health centre etc.
- 3.12 To establish and develop such out of school/extra-curricular activities centres for the children of the under-privileged class/section of society, where they could have the benefits and joy of participating in sports, games, artistic work and activities and also organise educational trips etc.
- 3.13 To establish, maintain and/or support libraries, museums, documentation (including audio-visual records) and reading rooms for advancement of education and knowledge.
- 3.14 To publish books, charts, illustrations, journals, magazines, periodicals, leaflets, and other necessary literature and/or to adopt other medias on different subjects and in different languages for the promotion of education and upliftment of people and to achieve the aims and objects of the Trust.
- 3.15 To organise symposium, conferences, seminars, study circle, meetings, workshops etc. and to conduct research in education and other disciplines on different subjects relating to or in any manner connected with education.
- 3.16 To collect, accept and receive donations, grants in aid, contributions, subscriptions, request and other aid, assistance in cash or in kind, presents and other offerings (in the shape of moveable and immoveable property) from the State/Central Government, semi government authorities, bodies and offices, Public sector undertakings, banks, institutions, individuals, Companies, Trusts, Firms, Corporations, Co-operative Societies national and international agencies or from any other donor.
- 3.17 To contribute or to grant aid or assistance or to take over or to tie with any other institution, trust, Society, Organisation etc. for carrying out the objects of the Trust.
- 3.18 To arrange and organise social, cultural and educational functions, programmes from time to time.
- 3.19 To erect, construct, alter, maintain, re-construct, mortgage, transfer, uncharge, improve, manage and/or develop all or any part of property/building of the Trust or any of the abovenamed schools etc.

3.20 To purchase, acquire land for schools and other educational institutions and to construct, maintain and promote construction and establishment of schools, educational institutions, Hostels, Community halls, residence etc. for teachers, staff members, reasearch scholars etc.

3.21 To organise and manage other charitable services for the needy people.

3.22 To equip any of the schools, educational institutions etc. with necessary books, furnitures, equipments, instruments, and accessories etc.

3.23 To undertake, carry out, initiate, promote, sponsor and/or assist in any educational or any other development project and/or programmes among the poor, needy and backward people irrespective of any class, caste, creed, sex, religion, colour or race.

3.24 To make correspondences in lawful manner to solve the problems of the society.

3.25 To do all acts, things, and activities which are conducive necessary and incidental for carrying on the objects of the Trust as referred to herein above.

4. BENEFICIARIES:

All the mankind without any discrimination of nationality, state hood, religion, caste, creed, colour or sex, shall be the beneficiaries of the TRUST. This Trust shall exist solely for philanthropic purposes and not for the purposes of profit.

5. INCOME AND INVESTMENTS:

5.1 Notwithstanding any thing hereinafter contained, the income as also the corpus of the trust estate shall be applied and be available only to or for the purposes of the trust as set out hereindabove and subject to such conditions or limitations if any, as may from time to time be laid down in the Income Tax Act, 1961, or any other enactment in modification or substitution thereof governing taxation of income for the time being in force as will ensure or may or may not the Trust and its

Income as eligible for exemption from taxation under the Income Tax Act or any other replacement, re enactment or modification thereof so that any donation to the Trust Estate be recognised as eligible for exemption for tax in regard to the donor/donee.

5.2 Subject to the aforesaid the Trustees shall have power to invest the money(ies) of the Trust:-

(a) In any of the deposits of nati-onalized Bank or any other schedule Bank or any Government securities and other modes of investments as may be laid down under the Government guidelines in this behalf,

(b) In the purchase of lands or buildings or in the construction of buildings required for the purpose of the Trust provided that no such investment shall be made except with the previous sanction of the majority of total number of Trustees recorded by means of a resolution.

(c) In fixed or current deposit, deposit in debentures or debenture stock of any Firm, Bank, Company, Corporation or institutions approved by the Trustees.

5.3 An investment made in any manner authorized herein shall not be improper by reason only of the fact that any one or more of the Trustees are interested as Directors, Managing Directors, Share holders, Partners in the Firm, Bank, Company or institution in which any part of the funds of the Trust may be invested.

5.4 If in the opinion of the Trustees the property of the Trust is deteriorating or is not yielding a reasonable income or that its sale or conversion into a property of another kind would be advantageous to the Trust, the Trustees may exchange or convert the same for a property of another kind or sell the property and invest the sale proceeds in the manner herein mentioned.

5.5 The Trustees shall have full power to call in and convert into cash the Trust property(ies) and realise any or all of the securities and investments and to reinvest them in the manner herein mentioned.

5.6 If at any time the Trustees shall be desirous of handing over any part of the Trust Estate and its accumulated income to any public institution or any other Trust which is recognised under the Income Tax Act, 1961, or to any Governmental or other security or authority, they may do so on such terms and conditions as they may think fit but nevertheless make it a condition that such Trust or Institutions shall carry out the objects of the Trust Estate only.

5.7 The investment of the Trust Estate or the interest or income thereof or any part thereof shall always be kept in the name of the Trust and in case of the account and deposit as aforesaid, the same shall be dealt with or operated upon in such manner as may be decided by the Trustees from time to time and if necessary the Trustees may give a Power of Attorney to any scheduled bank or institution to realise the income of the Trust Estate and to collect the same on behalf of the Trust.

6. The number of Trustees shall, at no time be less than five and more than 15. If at any time, the number of Trustees falls below the minimum prescribed herein, the continuing Trustees can act only for the purpose of filling the vacancy or vacancies.

7. The Trustees on the Trust preferably shall be the family members of late Lala Jagannath only, i.e. his three sons and two daughters, and their kith and kin. In case of any vacancy amongst the Trustees occasioned by death, resignation, or incapacity of any Trustee or otherwise, the remaining Trustees may in their absolute discretion appoint another Trustee to fill up the vacancy, after mutual consultation and deliberation. However, both the posts of Chairman and Secretary shall never be occupied or held by the family of any single descendant of late Lala Jagannath ji.

8. FUNCTIONS OF THE TRUST:

(1) Appointment of the members on the Governing Body/Managing Committee of various educational institutions/Schools etc. including Lilawati Vidya Mandir Sr. Sec. School; R.B.Nam Hoop Vidya Mandir Sr. Sec. School; Lilawati Vidya Mandir Montessori School; and Heritage Play Centre and also the Manager and Chairman of these Schools.

- (2) Financial aid to R.B. Ram Roop Vidya Mandir Sr. Sec. school to the extent of 5%, it being a Government aided school.
- (3) Supervisory role.
- (4) Approval of the budget estimates of the schools and other educational institutions run or managed by the Trust.
- (5) Filling of vacancies caused by death, resignation or otherwise of any member of the Managing Committee of the schools and educational institutions under its control.
- (6) To ensure that all the accounts of schools and educational institutions, account of Fund, income and expenditure of schools and educational institutions etc. are properly maintained as per the rules.
- (7) To ensure that proper discipline/decorum is maintained in schools and educational institutions and they run within the Rules and Regulations provided by the Delhi School Education Act, and the rules framed there under and carry out and follow all other orders, directions, notifications and ordinances issued from time to time.
- (8) To ensure that the members appointed by it on the Managing Committee of these schools and institutions, including the Chairman, Manager etc. maintain decorum/discipline and take necessary disciplinary action, if required, against any of them, if found guilty of misconduct or otherwise.
- (9) To invest the surplus, if any, transferred from the schools, institutions etc. in promoting and development of new educational ventures and activities.

9. TERMINATION OR CESSATION OF TRUSTEES.

9.1: The Chairman and the Secretary of the Trust jointly have the power to suspend or terminate any of the Trustees after recording the reasons in writing on any of the following grounds:-

- a) on his/her death,
- b) on his/her written resignation.

- c) If he/she is found guilty of misconduct/false propoganda of the activities of the Trust.
- d) If he/she is found to be involved in any anti social activities
- e) If he/she is adjudged by the Competent Court of law to be a criminal offender or of unsound mind.
- f) If he/she disregards the rules and regulations of the Trust and/or working against the interest of the Trust or against the objectives of the Trust.

9.2. The reason for cessation/termination from the membership of the Trust shall be communicated to the member concerned. A trustee expelled from the membership of the Trust shall have no right to enjoy the 'Rights and Privileges' mentioned below.

10. RIGHTS & PRIVILEGES OF THE TRUSTEES.

All the members of the Trust:-

- 1) have one vote at every meeting.
- 2) shall be entitled to participate in the Trust meetings, cultural and/or religious functions and lawful gatherings, called or arranged by the Trust.
- 3) have the right to inspect the books and minutes of the Trust after taking due permission from the Secretary of the Trust.


11. DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES.

- 3) attend the meetings of the Trust.
- 4) give the necessary informations to the Trust pertaining to any matter which is necessary to be known by the Trust.
- 5) not indulge in activities which are prejudicial to the interest of the Rules and regulations of the Trust.

12 FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES.

- (a) All the Trustees shall be responsible for the management and administration of the affairs of the Trust. The President/Chairman and the Secretary are jointly authorised to appoint any trustees to look after any particular matter/function or the property of the Trust.
- (b) All the decisions on the various issues regarding the welfare of the Trust/school/institution shall be taken up and decided in the meeting of the Trust through reconciliation amicably. On any issue if decision is not taken through deliberations/consensus it be put to vote and if the votes are evenly decided, the President/Chairman shall have the power to cast the casting vote.
- (c) The President/Chairman and the Secretary of the Trust shall jointly execute all the agreements and contracts and sign all important papers, legal documents, deeds, including sale deed, licence/lease deed and get the same registered in accordance with law.
- (d) The Trustees shall prepare the plans and programmes for the upliftment and carrying out the aims and objects of the Trust.
- (e) To receive, to keep in custody, to invest and to spend the funds/moneys and/or immoveable properties and to administer and manage the same.
- (f) The President/Chairman and the Secretary shall appoint/terminate any employee/staff required for the effective management of the affairs of the Trust and/or to maintain the discipline.
- (g) To arrange finance, funds, donations etc. from banks, companies, institutions, individuals etc. on reasonable terms and conditions.
- (h) To accept and receive donations, charities, funds, grants, moneys, loans, properties, legacies etc.

- (i) from time to time make and prescribe rules and regulations and bye laws etc. for carrying out the aims and objects of the Trust and for the administration of the affairs of the schools, educational institutions etc. managed, maintained, controlled and/or conducted by the Trust and all other matter incidental to the working of the Trust, and from time to time modify, add, amend, or alter such rules, regulations and/or bye laws.
- (j) To elect or nominate the office bearers from amongst themselves to carry out the objectives of the Trust.
- (k) To take all steps that may be necessary or required for the preservation of the trust, the Trust properties and the title of the Trust to the Trust properties.

13. NOTICE TO THE TRUSTEES.

Not less than seven (7) days clear notice shall be given to the members of the Trust, before the date of the meeting of the Trust, enclosing the agenda specifying the date, time and place and the nature of the business to be discussed at such a meeting.

14. QUORUM.

The quorum of the meeting of the Trust shall be minimum of four (4) from the total strength of the Trustees. If the required quorum is not present in any such meeting, the meeting shall be adjourned for a further period of 15 days.

15. ELECTION:

The Trustees in its annual meeting shall elect/appoint/nominate amongst themselves the President/Chairman and the Secretary of the trust for a term of five (5) years. They shall be eligible for re-election, re-appointment, re-election for a further term of five years and so on. Mr. Raj Kumar Gupta and Mr. Harsh Gupta are the first Chairman and Secretary respectively of the Trust, who shall hold their respective offices for five years from

the date of registration of this Trust Deed and shall be eligible for re-appointment/re-nomination/re-election as stated above.

16 OFFICE BEARERS:

16.1 THE CHAIRMAN:

Except or otherwise provided, the Chairman shall be subject to the control and supervision of the Trust, have the power of general direction and management of the affairs relating to the Trust.

- (1) In case of any proceedings or meetings of the Trust, the decisions of the Chairman/president shall be considered as final in case of dispute as to the meaning or interpretation of any rule etc.
- (2) At the time of voting on any subject, issue or agenda, except elections, if the votes of the Trustees happen to be equal, the chairman shall have the power to cast a casting vote in order to resolve the matter and to decide the issue.
- (3) The chairman shall have the power to allow inclusion of any subject, matter, or thing in the agenda for discussions in the course of meetings/proceedings.
- (4) The Chairman shall preside over the meetings of the Trust.
- (5) The Chairman shall be the chief executive of the Trust and shall do all the acts, deeds, matters and things, which may be required, necessary and expedient to achieve the objects of the Trust, in consultation with the Secretary.

16.2 THE SECRETARY:

- (1) In the absence of the Chairman of the Trust, the Secretary shall preside over the meetings of the Trust.
- (2) He will prepare all the necessary documents, papers etc. called by the Chairman or otherwise necessary for smooth functioning of the Trust.
- (3) He will issue notices/ agendas and other details etc. to the Trustees/members of the Trust and attend all meetings of the Trust and shall keep, record and maintain


- (4) He will prepare, maintain and keep the membership register showing full details and particulars of all the members of the Trust and shall supply certified copies of the documents, deeds, registered etc. under his signatures.
- (5) He will keep and maintain the account books and shall get the accounts of the Trust audited and place before the members/Trustees the annual balance sheet/profit and loss account of the Trust.
- (6) He shall operate, open and sign all the Bank papers, accounts, deposits, instruments, deeds etc. jointly with the Chairman.
- (7) He shall send the list of the members appointed by the Trust on the respective governing body of all the schools/institutions under its management, and control, to the authorities concerned.
- 16.3 The Trustees may elect, appoint or nominate any other office bearer, besides the above.

17. ADVISORY BOARD.


- 17.1 The Trustees are authorised to appoint/nominate at any time advisory board consisting of the experts, professionals etc. to take necessary advise and/or to solve any issue/matter or dispute or to obtain any opinion or advice. The Chairman and the Secretary of the Trust shall be members of the advisory board alongwith others.
- 17.2 Any Trustees being any professional or any other person/professionals engaged/retained by the Trust shall be entitled to be paid all the usual professional fees/charges/remuneration/honorarium etc. for the time spent, business transacted and acts done by him/them (including acts which a trustee not being in any profession or business could have done personally) in spite of the fact that he shall be a trustee of the Trust.
- 17.3 The Chairman, secretary and other Trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses legally and properly

incurred by them in or about the execution of the Trust and/or in the discharge of the duties imposed on them.

18. FINANCIAL YEAR.

The financial year of the Trust shall end on 31st day of March each year. The audited accounts of the Trust and the report of the auditors shall be placed before the meeting of the board of Trustees.

19. ACCOUNTS AND AUDITS:

The Trust shall maintain and keep regular and proper accounts of all receipts, payments, properties, assets and liabilities. Such accounts shall be got audited by a Chartered Accountant. Such accounts shall be kept and maintained at the office of the Trust and shall be in direct charge of the Secretary of the Trust.

20. BANK ACCOUNT(S):

The board of Trustees may from time to time open and maintain, in the name of the Trust, bank account(s) with nationalised and/or scheduled Banks or financial institutions and the same shall be operated under the joint signatures of the Chairman and the Secretary of the Trust.

21. LEGAL PROCEEDINGS:

The Trust may sue and/or be sued in the name of the Secretary of the Trust.

22. WINDING UP:

The Trust may terminate its activities if the board of Trustees deem it necessary in their meeting called and held for the purpose by giving at least twenty one days notice and passing a resolution by at least three fourth majority of the total number of the Trustees, either present in person or by consent in writing or by both ways and may wind up the affairs of the Trust.

On this winding up no part of the Trust property shall be distributed among the Trustees, donors or their relatives and all the properties of the Trust shall be handed over to a trust, society, institution, or organisation having same or similar objects or the present Trust may

23. MISCELLANEOUS:

- 23.1 It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust fund/property or its income shall be applied for the purpose which is not in accordance with the object of the Trust.
- 23.2 None of the Trustees shall be entitled to be paid any remuneration for working as Trustees except to the extent stated elsewhere in this deed.
- 23.3 The Trustees shall conform to the provisions of the Indian Trust Act, 1881, or any modification or replacement thereof, in all matters not expressly provided for herein, but in case any difficulty or doubt arise on any question in respect of the management or administration of the Trust or any matter falling hereunder, the Secretary may, on behalf of the board of Trustees, apply to the Court for opinion, advice, direction or order.
- 23.4 It is hereby agreed and declared that this Trust is a public charitable Trust and shall be got registered and recognised in accordance with the provisions of the Central or State Laws in force in India from time to time, including the Income Tax Act, 1961.
